ties, be thereunto first had and obtained, and that they cause their said Mar-
riage to be openly solemnized in the Face of the Parish Church of Abbots
Bromley aforesaid

between the Hours of Eight and
Twelve of the Clock in the Forenoon: And do and shall save harmless and
keep indemnified the abovenamed Richard Rider
his Surrogates and all others his Officers, and Successors in Office, for, and
concerning the Premises:

Then the said Obligation to be Void, or else to be and remain in full Force
and Virtue.
