

AT Colwick -- the second day of January
1800 before the Reverend John Pitchford A. M.
Surrogate, &c.

On which Day appeared personally Charles Thompson -- of the Parish
of Abbots Bromley -- in the County of Stafford -- and
Diocese of Lichfield & Coventry --
and being sworn on the holy Evangelists made oath as follows (to wit) That he

is of the age of Twenty seven Years and upwards, and a Bachelor
and intends to marry Mary Gates -- of the Parish of
Colwick -- in the County aforesaid -- and Diocese
of Lichfield & Coventry --
being Twenty eight Years and upwards: not knowing or
believing any lawful let or impediment by reason of any precontract consanguinity,
affinity, or any other lawful cause whatsoever, to hinder the said intended marri-
age: WHEREFORE he prayed a Licence to be granted to him, to solemnize the
said marriage in the parish Church of Colwick
aforesaid, in which said Parish of Colwick
the said Charles Thompson -- also made oath, that the said
Mary Gates -- hath had her usual abode for the
space of four Weeks last past.
