OATH OF ALLEGIANCE

I hereby declare, on oath, that I absolutely and entirely renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Augusto Presagueron, any Independent State, within Bounds of the Russian Soviet Republic, of whom I have heretofore been a subject; that I will support and defend the Constitution and laws of the United States of America against all enemies, foreign and domestic; and that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the same.

NOTE—In consideration of this act of naturalization, and the following in the oath of allegiance before it is inserted: "I further renounce the title of 'citizen', as an order of nobility, which I have heretofore held."

ORDER OF COURT ADMITTING PETITIONER

It is further ordered, upon consideration of the petition of the said Vasily Kosty, that his name be, and hereby is, changed to Charles Kosty, under authority of the provisions of section 6 of the act approved June 20, 1906 (34 Stat. L., p. 600), as amended by the act approved March 3, 1913, entitled "An act to create a Department of Labor."
