this s<sup>d</sup> Fifty pounds at her Discretion amongst  
her Children when and at what time she thinks  
proper

Item I give and bequeath unto my Loving Son  
John Tompson Fifty pounds the value or  
what part thereof he shall think proper to be  
laid out and expended in my Funerall Charges  
and the Funerall Charges of my Dear Wife if  
she shall happen to Dy first

Item all the residue of my Effects I give and bequeath  
unto my s<sup>d</sup> Son John Except the annuity of  
w<sup>ch</sup> he is to pay Dear Wife according to agreement  
made with him

Lastly I do make Constitute and appoint my  
Dear Wife and Son John Executors of this my  
Last Will and Testament revoking and Disannulling  
any other former Will or Testament made by me  
In witness whereof I have hereunto put my  
hand and seal the 27<sup>th</sup> day of April One thousand  
Seven hundred and forty
