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SISTER JOACHIM, DIOCESAN TEACHER, IS DEAD AT 62

A Requiem Mass will be offered at 11 AM tomorrow in the Mt. St. Joseph Motherhouse, 2064 Main St., for Sister Mary Anne Joachim, SSJ, 62, a Diocesan schoolteacher for 22 years. Burial will be in Sisters of St. Joseph Cemetery, adjacent to the Motherhouse.

Sister Joachim, a sixth, seventh and eighth grade teacher throughout her career, died Wednesday (April 16, 1969) in Sisters Hospital after a long illness. She last taught at Our Mother of Good Counsel School in Blasdell. She retired two years ago.

The former Genevieve McCarthy, she also taught at St. Mark's, St. Joseph's, Blessed Trinity, St. Matthew's and Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, all in Buffalo; Our Lady of Victory in Lackawanna; St. Aloysius Gonzaga in Cheektowaga, and Sacred Heart of Jesus School in Dunkirk.

A native of Baldwinsville, she had earned a Master's Degree in education from Mt. St. Joseph Teachers College, forerunner of Medaille College here, and went on to Oswego State Normal School and Syracuse University for study in art and music.

Sister Joachim entered the order in 1944 after several years as a public schoolteacher in Baldwinsville. A year later, she came to Buffalo.

Survivors include a cousin, Sister Mary Laura, SSJ, a former music instructor at Mt. St. Joseph Academy, and nieces and nephews in the Syracuse area.

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
