**MRS. T. H. McCARTHY,
LIFE RESIDENT OF
BALDWINVILLE DIES**

Mrs. Teresa H. McCarthy, 70, of 96 East Genesee street, a native and life-long resident of this village, died at her home last Saturday after a long illness. She was the widow of Joseph McCarthy.

Surviving are two daughters, Sister Genevieve McCarthy, a nun stationed at Emmettsburg, Md., and Mrs. Lenora Hunter of Baldwinville; a brother, James H. Smith of Syracuse; two sisters, Mrs. Mary Anna McCarthy of Syracuse and Mrs. Helen Savage of Buffalo, and three grandchildren.

Funeral services were conducted from the home at 9 o'clock Tuesday morning, followed by a high mass of requiem at 9:30, the celebrant being Rev. H. Kirchen; deacon of the mass, Rev. Harold J. Flynn of Phoenix, and sub-deacon, the Rev. H. L. Contois of North Syracuse. In the sanctuary were the Rev. Charles Tracy, the Rev. John Alfred, and the Rev. Paul Long, all of St. Lucy's church, Syracuse. Six Sisters of Charity from Syracuse attended the funeral to represent Miss Genevieve McCarthy, daughter of the deceased, who is now a novitiate of the order at Emmettsburg, Md., who could not attend. Interment was made in St. Mary's cemetery.

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
