CRAWLS UNDER GIRLS' BED; NEGRO IS SENT TO PRISON

Joseph Swenton, aged 22, colored, of Harvey street, Corning, who quietly entered the home of Mike Kosty on East Tioga avenue Saturday night and crawled under a bed in the room of two young women of the household where he was discovered by them on their return home from a shopping expedition to the center of the city pleaded guilty to a charge of disorderly conduct when arraigned in City Court this morning and was sentenced to spend six months in the Monroe County Penitentiary. Swenton, according to the police had been drinking.

Swenton failed to conceal himself securely under the bed however and when the young women entered the room they saw his feet protruding from under the bed. Mr. Kosty who was in the house immediately called the police and Swenton was arrested.

This is the second time recently in which such an instance has come to light here.
