Health Score of Corning Is 770.9

Dr. Williams Reports to Health Officer Elwood on His Findings Here

A scoring of 770.9 out of a possible 1,000 points, with recommendations for action on a sewage disposal plant, is given the city by Dr. Huntington Williams, district State Health Officer, in a letter to Dr. H. E. Elwood, city health officer, whom he commends for his efficient, consistent work as health executive of the city.

Dr. Williams expresses hope that Corning will adopt the new state milk code "for the sake of easier enforcement and uniformity" and urges greater toxin-antitoxin protection for at least 25 per cent of the children in Corning, who are under the school age.

The letter follows:
