

# MARCELLA PHALEN DIES IN NEW YORK

## Nurse Was Native of Florence; Ill for Only Short Time

Camden, March 14.—Miss Marcella A. Phalen, R. N., 48, died yesterday in New York City following a brief illness.

She was born in Florence Sept. 16, 1892, daughter of the late Martin and Bridget Courtney Phalen. She was graduated from St. Mary's Training School, Niagara Falls, and was employed as nurse there for several years before going to New York City where she continued to practice her profession.

Surviving are two brothers, Ambrose Phalen, Dubuque, Ia., and James Phalen, Cleveland, O.; three sisters, Mrs. Fred Gagnon and Miss Helen Phalen, New York City, and Mrs. Ernest Brewster, Camden.

The body will arrive in Camden Saturday morning and will be taken to the home of Mrs. Brewster on Fayette St. Funeral services will be held at the home at 9:30 Monday and a half an hour later in St. John's Church.

Burial will be made in St. Mary's Cemetery.
