traffic infraction the learner is charged with.

Richard P. Kosty, 17, of 79 Wardell St., Corning, was arrested Saturday afternoon at 2:30 on Rt. 17 by State Police Trooper T. J. Chura and charged with driving 75 miles an hour. Kosty was operating on a learner's permit.

He was accompanied by Gregory B. Kosty, 19, of the same

address, a licensed operator.

They were arraigned before Town of Big Flats Peace Justice Leon Wartars. Both admitted the speeding charge. Gregory Kosty paid a fine of \$25 and Richard Kosty's case was adjourned until Monday.

Wartars said a licensed operator is liable for the same traffic infraction with which a learner is charged, except when the person

being taught to drive is accompanied by a driving school instructor.
