

# Sheriff Page and Officers Seize Wet Goods in Raids

Corning, April 11.—Sheriff W. B. Page, assisted by Federal agents and members of the Corning police force, made three raids in Corning yesterday afternoon, seizing two stills and large quantities of alleged gin, wine and whiskey.

A large still and several jugs of alleged moonshine was found at the home of Mary Kosty of 84 East

Tioga avenue. The National Hotel on East Market street, operated by Joseph Vincenzo, netted a quantity of alleged wine, whiskey and gin. A large still and a quantity of alleged wine and moonshine was taken at the home of John Speck at 338 Oak street. The officers destroyed 120 gallons of mash found at the Speck home.
