KOSTY PLACE HERE RAIDED

Federal Agents Secure Samples of Wet Goods; Owner is Arrested

Two Federal agents accompan-
ied by Officer Farrell made a raid
on the establishment of Charles
Kosty, at 172 East Market street,
about 6 o'clock last evening and
secured a quantity of beer and
some samples of alleged moon-
shine.

When the agents entered the
place, **Charles Kosty**, father of the
owner, was in charge, and when
he learned the cause of the visit
Kosty pulled a trap door dump-
ing a quantity of liquid into the
basement below. The officers hur-
ried to the basement and secured
samples of the spilled "wet goods"
which were taken for analysis.
Several bottles of beer were also
taken.

Both father and son were placed
under arrest and charged with
violating the Volsted act. When
arraigned before Commissioner
Tew they pleaded not guilty and
were each held on \$1,000 bail.
