

## Gets Compensation In Local Death Case

Mrs. Mary B. Kosty and three children of 174 East Market street, were awarded a weekly compensation by Referee John W. McCracken of Rochester in the death benefit case of Mrs. Kosty's deceased husband, Charles B. Kosty, Sr., heard Thursday afternoon at the Court house.

Mr. Kosty, a veteran employe at Corning Glass Works, died in July, 1939 of a pulmonary hemorrhage, Dr. W. C. Templer, CGW physician, testified at the hearing.

Referee McCracken stated that the award, limited at \$4,000, is payable at weekly rates based on a percentage of the average weekly earning of \$34.50 of the deceased. Mrs. Kosty will receive 30 per cent of this amount and 10 per cent will also be given for each of the three children under 21, Alex, Andrew and Elizabeth Kosty.
