

DECREE GRANTED

CHADDESDEN WOMAN ALLEGES MISCONDUCT OF HUSBAND

In the Divorce Court to-day Mr. Justice Henn Collins granted a decree nisi with costs to Mrs. Nellie Poole, of Buxton-road, Chaddesden, who petitioned for the dissolution of her marriage because of the misconduct of her husband, Ralph Poole, at an address in London in 1938. The suit was not defended.

Mr. and Mrs. Poole were married in July, 1929, at the Derby Register Office.

There are three children.

The case for Mrs. Poole was that in 1938 there was a deed of separation between her husband and herself. Later that year she learnt he had been associating with a woman in London and subsequently she brought divorce proceedings. Mrs. Poole was granted the custody of the children of the marriage.
