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Police Hunt Driver Missing After Car Plunges 65 Feet

Police last night were searching for Louis Joseph McCarthy, 60, of 162 Hastings pl, who was the alleged driver of a sedan that plunged about 65 feet over an embankment in State Fair blvd, just north of the railroad bridge

Patrolman Lisle Toms said the car apparently went out of control some distance before it went thru the wooden guard rail, as tire marks were evidenced about 40 feet along the railing off the shoulder of the road

The car was virtually undamaged and did not overturn when it came to a halt at the bottom of the embankment.

Mr. McCarthy probably escaped injury, Toms said as all hospitals were checked and he had not been treated there or in nearby physicians' offices. Police could not find him at home later in the evening.

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
