

Couple Asks \$12,500 After Sidewalk Fall

Two claims for damages of \$12,500 were filed yesterday against the City of Syracuse by a Syracuse couple. They grew from a fall on a sidewalk resulting in injuries to the woman.

Mrs. Frieda Garvey, 139 Culbert St., asks \$10,000 and her husband, Joseph Garvey, \$2,500, for loss of his wife's services and medical and surgical expenses.

The claimants allege Mrs. Garvey was walking south on the west side of Culbert St. at about 3 p.m. March 25 when she fell in front of the premises at Culbert and First North Sts. (900 First North St.).

The sidewalk allegedly was defective and the claimants assert the city was negligent and careless in permitting it to become and to remain in "uneven cracked and broken condition.

Mrs. Garvey claims to have suffered injuries about her legs, back and spine and severe shock to her nerves.
