

Mrs. Smith Dies; Former Actress, 56

A former actress in the radio show "One Man's Family," Mrs. Geraldine Smith, 56, of 98 Wellington Ave., Albany, died at St. Peter's Hospital after a brief illness Monday.

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Mrs. Smith was in the cast of the soap opera in the 1930s, carried over station WGY.

She also was instrumental in founding the Catholic Youth League in Schenectady during the 1930s. In recent years Mrs. Smith had been a housewife.

Survivors include her husband, Robert J. Smith Sr. of Albany; three daughters, Miss Mary Teresa Smith of Washington, D.C., Georgianna Smith and Mary Jude, both of Albany; two sons, Army Pvt. William J. Smith of Fort Polk, La., and Robert J. Smith Jr. of Albany; a nephew and two nieces.

Funeral services will be at 9:30 a.m. tomorrow at the Gleason Funeral Home and at 10 a.m. at St. John The Evangelist Church where a mass of requiem will be celebrated.

The funeral chapel will be open after 7 p.m. tonight.

Burial will be in Most Holy Redeemer Cemetery.
