

DROWNED WHILE SWIMMING.

John E. Sloan of New York Drowned at Jack's Reefs.

Baldwinsville, N. Y., July 22.—(Special.)—A sad drowning accident occurred at Jack's Reefs yesterday afternoon, which resulted in the death of John Edward Sloan. Mr. Sloan, who resides at New York, had been spending his vacation at his home at this place. Yesterday afternoon he went in bathing near the reefs, when he sank and before assistance could be rendered was drowned. It is thought that he was attacked with cramps, as he was a good swimmer.

Undertaker Smith was notified, and recovered the body and brought it to this place later in the evening.

Mr. Sloan was about twenty-seven years of age, and was a son of John Sloan of Snooky Hollow. He was a quiet unassuming man, and a large circle of acquaintances regret his untimely death.
